Introduction

If you live in the Parish of St. George's Waterlooville, or if you have a connection with St. George's you are normally entitled to be married in St. George's Church. Being married in church is to be married in a holy place and it is an opportunity to seek God's blessing. Every wedding is a unique occasion, and we feel a great sense of privilege in sharing this day with you.

Weddings are arranged with the Parish Office and Parish Priest. The first things to be done are to make sure you are entitled to be married here and then to fix the date and time of the wedding. Then, over the following months we build up a picture of the kind of wedding you would like to have. We shall need to know your choice of hymns, music and readings and who is going to take part in the service. Come along to the Parish Office on any Sunday to discuss your plans or telephone or email Fr Colin Lawlor if you prefer.

We work together to arrange the service that is right for you. Often, we produce an order of service for couples which has all the information that is needed on the day so that by the time of the wedding rehearsal (in the week before the wedding) everyone knows what is going to happen.

Fees

Please see the list of fees printed overleaf.

Statutory fees are those which must be paid. The "extras" will vary according to the decisions which you make about your wedding.

Banns

If you both live in Waterlooville your banns will be called here automatically. If one of you lives in another parish you must arrange for your banns to be called in that parish church within three months before your wedding. Banns will be called at St George's on dates arranged with Fr Colin, but can be no sooner than three months before the wedding.

Deposit

When you book your wedding a deposit of £100 is paid by you. Payment can be made by cheques (payable to "PCC St. George's" or by online bank transfer) and this is non-refundable. This enables us to guarantee the Church for you.

Photography

Discreet photography is permitted during the service and you are very welcome to use the church grounds before and after the service for photographs.



Video

Video recording is permitted and there is no additional charge. We ask that the camera operator be as discreet as possible in recording the service.

Parking

There is parking available in Wellington Retail Park (free for 3 hours - PO7 7FG) or Wellington Way Car Park (pay and display by Iceland – PO7 7ED) in Waterlooville. For weddings, the layby area close to the church is coned off for wedding cars.
